## **CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER UPDATED REQUIREMENT FOR FACE COVERINGS C19-12c:**

Good Afternoon,

On July 22, 2020, the City and County of San Francisco Department of Public Health issued Order No. C19-12c, which replaces the prior Face Covering order (Health Officer Order No. C19-12b) issued on May 28, 2020 and requires that members of the public and essential workers wear a Face Covering at all times while inside of Essential Businesses and Facilities with limited exceptions set forth in Section 3 of Order No. C19-12c. This order went into effect at 11:59 p.m., on July 23, 2020.

Per the July 22, 2020 San Francisco Department of Public Health Order# C19-12c:

- Essential Businesses and entities with workers engaged in Essential Infrastructure Work, Minimum Basic Operations, or Essential Governmental Functions who continue to operate at the Bay Area Metro Center must continue to require their employees and contractors to wear a Face Covering in the workplace except when in a completely enclosed private space or an isolated area not regularly used by others. Essential workers must also wear a Face Covering when interacting with the public, when working in or walking through common areas, in shared areas of buildings including lobbies, commonly shared rooms (conference rooms), cubicles, food preparation spaces, and bathrooms; and in any room or enclosed area when other people are present.
  - Per Section 3g of the Order, individuals who are unable to wear a Face Covering due to a medical condition must be able to show a written exemption provided by a medical professional.
- Personnel, contractors and visitors who need to enter the Bay Area Metro Center will be reminded by building security of the requirement that they wear a Face Covering while inside the building in accordance with the Shelter in Place Order. The Bay Area Metro Center will take all reasonable steps to prohibit anyone who is not wearing a Face Covering from entering and must not serve that person if those efforts are unsuccessful and seek to remove that person.
- Personnel, contractors and visitors must also wear a Face Covering when outside of the Bay Area Metro Center where distances between people change frequently and often come to six feet or less, such as the sidewalk areas outside of the Bay Area Metro Center or within the Rincon breezeway.
