STAY SAFE AT HOME – SHELTER IN PLACE ORDER C19-07e (updated June 1, 2020)

Good Afternoon,

On June 1, 2020, the City and County of San Francisco Department of Public Health issued an updated version of Order No. C19-07e, which superseded and modified the prior shelter in place order with no specific expiration date.

This order updates Appendix A to Order No. C19-07e to include new requirements in the Social Distancing Protocol.

Per San Francisco Department of Public Health Order No. C19-07e as updated June 1, 2020:

- All Essential Businesses must prepare, post, and implement an *updated* Social Distancing Protocol to address new requirements listed in Appendix A of Order No. C19-07e **by June 15, 2020**. The updated Social Distancing Protocol must be posted at or near the entrance of the relevant facility, distributed to all personnel and shall be easily viewable by the public and personnel. Essential businesses must also educate all personnel on the requirements of the Social Distancing Protocol and any other Health Officer directive that applies. - A copy of the updated Social Distancing Protocol implemented by the Bay Area Headquarters Authority for the Bay Area Metro Center (BAMC) is attached to this notice.
- Order No. C19-07e does not affect Order No C19-12b (requiring face coverings), which will continue indefinitely until otherwise directed by the Health Officer. Essential Businesses and entities with workers engaged in Essential Infrastructure Work, Minimum Basic Operations, or Essential Governmental Functions who continue to operate at BAMC **must** require their employees and contractors to continue to wear a Face Covering in accordance with Order No. C19-12b at the workplace when interacting with the public, when working in or walking through common areas, and in any room or enclosed area when other people are present.
